



NSA West Before/After School Program

The NSA West Before/After School Program will be open to Kindergarten – 5th graders for the 2010-2011 school year with an initial focus on the general wellness of participating students. This will include optional nutrition (breakfast and/or snack), homework help, and a variety of activities that allow for “down time,” such as free play and physical exercise.

Over time, the goal is to expand the program to include more extra-curricular and enrichment opportunities such as sports, fine arts, and intellectual clubs. The school values input from interested parents and plans to offer an annual survey to determine the best options for expansion of the program.

Staff

Attracting highly qualified staff to manage the program is a priority and important to the quality and success of this important service to working families. For the safety and well-being of our students, there will be one staff member for every 20 children. The Head of School will be responsible for supervising the Before/After School Program staff.

Schedule

The program will be open one hour before school and for three hours after school. The program will follow the same 10 month calendar as the NSA West school calendar and will be closed on holidays, teacher in-service days, and snow days when school is not in session.

Enrollment & Tuition

In year one there will be 40 spaces available in the program with first priority given to families with parent(s) and/or caregivers who work full-time and need care *both* before and after school care. If spaces remain available, they will continue to be filled with students needing part-time care.

Parents will have the option to order breakfast in the morning and/or snack in the afternoon for their child(ren) at an additional cost.
